Overview

Why are the EU and SA cooperating in higher education?

- SA is a Strategic Partner and HE is a key area identified for the exchange of ideas, knowledge and expertise on issues of mutual interest with a view to improving the quality of HE on both sides
- In addition EU funded programmes and activities offer opportunities for SA to address some of its development challenges (e.g. high-level HR) and to meet some of its strategic objectives (e.g. internationalisation of HE)

Action 1: Erasmus Mundus Masters Courses Erasmus Mundus Joint Doctorates

A course (masters or doctorate) . . .
developed and delivered by a consortium of universities...
located in at least three European countries and...
co-ordinated by a European university (non-European universities can be partners)



Action 1: Erasmus Mundus Masters Courses Erasmus Mundus Joint Doctorates


An Erasmus Mundus course:

- offers an integrated study/research programme, fully recognised in the countries participating
- requires study or research in at least two countries in the consortium
- leads to the award of a double, multiple or joint degree to all successful students



Action 1: Erasmus Mundus Masters Courses Erasmus Mundus Joint Doctorates


- Full-study scholarships are available for students
- Short term scholarships are available for academics
- Applicants compete with applicants from all over the world
- 85% of Erasmus Mundus courses are taught in English



Action 1: Erasmus Mundus Masters Courses (EMMC) Erasmus Mundus Joint Doctorates (EMJD)

From 2004-2011:

- More than 200 Masters courses and more than 30 Doctorates selected
- Scholarships awarded to 12,000 Masters students, nearly 350 Doctoral students, and 1,230 academics
- A wide range of disciplines, including
 - Agriculture and food science, energy and environmental sciences, engineering, mathematics & ICT, natural sciences, social sciences

Erasmus Mundus Action 2: Partnerships

- > To contribute to the provision of appropriate high-level skills for sustainable development and growth in SA
- > To strengthen political, economic and cultural links between the EU and SA
- > Grant funding to partnerships of European and SA HEIs
- > Funding covers scholarships for SA masters and doctoral students and HEI staff to European HEIs
- > Annual financial commitments for SA (€5 m in 2009, €3 m in 2010, €5 m in 2011, €5 m? in 2012 & 2013)

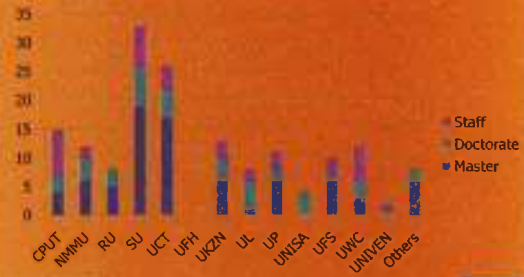

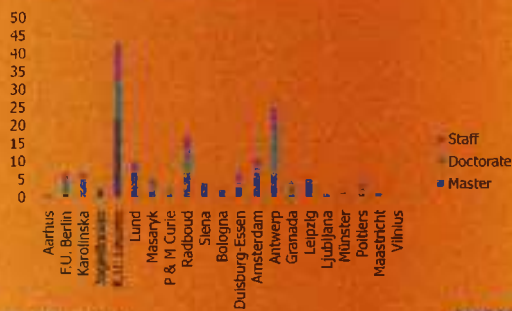
